


## SG Arrival Card

All delegates are required to submit the [SG Arrival Card](#) with Electronic Health Declaration within 3 days (including the day of arrival) before arriving in Singapore. For example, if you are arriving in Singapore on April 15, 2026 you can submit your declaration from April 13, 2026 onwards.

As part of the SG Arrival Card (SGAC) submission, you are required to submit the electronic health declaration for purposes of disease control, specifically to guard against importing diseases of concern, to protect the health of Singapore residents. Those who make false declarations may be prosecuted under the Infectious Diseases Act.

## Visa & Passport

Most delegates do not require a visa for tourism stays of 30 to 90 days. Nationals of some countries do require a visa, which can often be easily obtained online and received in printable format. [Click here](#) to find out if you need an entry visa.

All visitors must produce a passport valid for 6 months from the date of departure, proof of sufficient funds for the duration of their stay, a return or onward ticket, visa for the following destination (if applicable), and a yellow fever vaccination certificate (please consult the up-to-date list of countries whose national require vaccination at your planned travel dates).

## How to Get Here

Singapore Changi Airport is recognised as one of the best airports in the world. Both of its terminals are linked by a skytrain, which operates at the transit and public areas as well as Terminal 3.

The Capitol Kempinski Hotel Singapore is easily accessible by car, taxi and Singapore's tube network known as the MRT. City Hall MRT station is linked to the hotel by a convenient underpass, accessed from Arcade @ The Capitol Kempinski.

- By Taxi: All taxis are air-conditioned and the fares are metre. Payment can be made in cash or by any major credit card. Fares vary during non-peak and peak hours due to toll fares added automatically to the metre at gantry points on selected roads at selected times. The 18 km ride from the airport usually and costs SGD 25-30.

## Language

Official languages are English, Malay, Mandarin and Tamil. The generally good command of English makes it easy for visitors to get around.

## General Etiquette

Singapore is considered one of the cleanest cities in the world. Littering and chewing gum are strictly prohibited and result in severe fines. Also, eating and drinking on public transport and public smoking are not allowed.

## Packing Tips

Prepare for heat, humidity and rain. We recommend lightweight breathable clothing, including comfortable walking shoes and rain gear for daytime activities.

## Weather

With its tropical rainforest climate, Singapore does not have any seasons, and throughout the year one can experience uniform temperatures between 22 and 35°C (72 to 95°F), high humidity and abundant rainfall.

## Currency & Tipping

The local currency is the Singapore dollar (SGD), and prices are usually quoted excluding VAT and a service charge. All major credit cards are widely accepted.

**Tipping Guidelines:** Tipping is generally not expected in Singapore.

- Most restaurants and hotels include a 10% service charge
- Airport staff are forbidden from accepting tips

## Electrical Plugs

Singapore uses 220-240 volts, 50 Hz AC and type-G plugs, which are the same used in the UK.

## Medications and Narcotics

Some medications that are legal in many countries like Australia or the United Kingdom are restricted in Singapore. This includes some painkillers, cold and flu medications and ADHD medications. If you are planning to travel with medication, you may need to apply for approval from Singapore's Health Sciences Authority.

Please also be advised that narcotics and psychotropic drugs are strictly prohibited by the Government of Republic of Singapore and may result in severe penalties (including the death penalty).
